This month in Egypt—the land of the Great Pyramids and the Nile River—the majority of the population will celebrate Ramadan. The Ramadan holiday represents an extended time of fasting, prayer, reflection and gathering in community. Let's pray that as Egyptians come with seeking hearts, Jesus will reveal Himself!



Did you know?

- Egypt is home to the world's longest river, the Nile. As a baby, Moses was placed in a basket in the Nile (Exodus 2:3).
- ► The Sahara and Libyan deserts cover most of Egypt. Only about .79" of rain falls each year in the deserts.
- Out of all the countries in the Middle East, Egypt has the most Facebook users.
- Many say the tradition of exchanging wedding rings began in ancient Egypt around 4000 B.C. The left ring finger was chosen because they believed there was a "vein of love" that ran from there directly to the heart.
- ► The Steppe Eagle is the national animal of Egypt. Since it lives in areas without trees, it makes a nest on the ground unlike the majority of eagles, who build their nests near the top of trees.



Praying for Egypt






Week 1 Prayers



□ Day 1 Pray that ministry teams in Egypt would work together in unity for the expansion of God's kingdom.
 □ Day 2 Pray for churches and ministries to be effective in sowing broadly to reach the majority in this region.
□ Day 3 In the verse below, the apostle Paul clearly encourages us to pray for everyone. Let's pray for every Egyptian person to know what is true and be saved!
"I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people. This is good, and pleases God our Savior, who wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth." — 1 Timothy 2:1, 3-4, NIV
□ Day 4 Pray for God to abundantly provide the financial resources needed for Christian outreach in Egypt.
□ Day 5 Ask God to grant churches and ministries in Egypt wisdom as they make plans to send more Christian worker into other parts of Egypt as well as into other countries.
□ Day 6 Pray that Christian Egyptians already serving on the mission field would continually seek God's wisdom and trust Him for fruit-bearing ministries.
 □ Day 7 Pray for wisdom and creativity for campus ministries as they plan gospel outreaches to university students.



Week 2 Prayers



□ Day 8

Pray for the Egyptian president and government, that they would govern well and make choices for the good of its people.

□ Day 9

Pray that Egypt's people and country would be kept safe from anyone who might want to do harm. Pray they put their trust in God.

□ Day 10

Pray for poverty to be mitigated in the many places it exists in Egypt and that those who have little will become rich with salvation, peace and joy found only in God who loves them.

□ Day 11

Pray for God's wisdom and blessing upon the Christian church in Egypt-that its people will live out biblical truth and share their faith, thus transforming the heart of this country.

□ Day 12

Pray this verse for every Christian in Egypt:

"Teach me your way, Lord, that I may rely on Your faithfulness; give me an undivided heart, that I may fear your name." - Psalm 86:11, NIV

Add names or whole groups of people into the verse to make it more specific. For example: "Lord, teach Christians in Egypt what You want them to do. May they rely on You. Teach them to fear (respect) You completely."

□ Day 13

Pray for biblical unity in the church of Egypt among leaders who serve the Lord and among all believers.

□ Day 14

Pray for Christians in Egypt who are in places of leadership throughout the country-that their influence for the Lord would be greatly felt throughout society and among new and seasoned believers.



Week 3 Prayers



□ Day 15

Join me in praying that all Egyptian Christians will faithfully read the Bible, learn what God wants them to do, then do it:

"And may your hearts be fully committed to the Lord our God, to live by His decrees and obey His commands, as at this time." - 1 Kings 8:61, NIV"

□ Day 16

Ask God to bless Egyptians with media and tools they can use to talk about Jesus. May God help the people use them efficiently, so that every person in Egypt can hear the gospel in a way that draws them in and speaks the language of their hearts.

□ Day 17

Pray for more believers to be trained to help others grow in their faith.

□ Day 18

Pray for churches and ministries in Egypt to work together effectively as partners in the gospel.

□ Day 19

Ask God to help and strengthen Egyptian Christians when they face challenges—especially any pressure against their faith.

□ Day 20

Pray that Christians will take advantage of calendar events and special days—like holidays and gatherings—as an opportunity to minister to others and serve the Lord.

□ Day 21

Pray for more Egyptian Christians to be trained to use media and web-based resources to share the gospel with others and help new believers grow in their relationship with Jesus.



Week 4 Prayers



□ Day 22 Pray for digital ministries in Egypt to make a powerful impact. These ministries include churches that meet online and discipleship websites that mentor believers.
□ Day 23 Pray for more full-time Christian workers across Egypt. May God lead people in every segment of society to step out in faith and serve Him. Pray that ministry leaders would have wisdom from God to strategically focus on Egyptians' greatest spiritual needs.
□ Day 24 Pray that ministry leaders would have wisdom from God to strategically focus on the greatest needs in our society.
□ Day 25 Join with me in praying this prayer written by Paul for the Christians in Ephesus. Today, pray this for Christian in Egypt.
"I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know Him better." — Ephesians 1:17, NIV
□ Day 26 Pray for Christian publishers to effectively spread God's Word and other Christian resources through book fairs.
□ Day 27 Pray for those ministering to the poor—that by serving in practical ways they may also have opportunities to share the message of the gospel.
□ Day 28 Ask God to provide for all the spiritual, emotional, physical and financial needs of full-time Christian workers in Egypt.



Week 5 Prayers

□ Day 29

Egyptian churches are in need of trainers who can model and train others in biblical living and how to share their faith. These trainees would then train others. Pray God raises up many trainers to serve in Egypt.

□ Day 30

Lord Jesus, we thank You for giving us a chance to pray for Egypt each day this month. We believe You will continue Your work there until everyone has heard clearly about Jesus and been invited to follow Him. Someday we'll see how You answered our prayers. May heaven be filled with Egyptian people who started to follow Jesus in part due to our prayers this month. We give you all honor and praise.
